Superintendent's Letter

On November 8, our district ran a \$5,000,000 general obligation bond issue, Proposition K.I.D.S. (Keep Improving District Schools), to address the following:

Junior High/High School Building:

- · Construct eight additional classrooms on the west side of the building
- Add and upgrade security cameras
- Complete masonry repairs along the gymnasium wall to prevent further leaks
- Purchase technology, furnishings, fixtures, and equipment for the new classrooms

Elementary Building:

- Regrade existing playground
- Purchase new playground equipment
- Install a new HVAC system
- Purchase a new speaker system for the gymnasium

It is important to recognize that planning began this past spring with the preparation of our Comprehensive School Improvement Plan (CSIP). For Proposition K.I.D.S. to pass, we needed a four-sevenths (57.14%) majority.

According to the official general election report for Cole County:

Total Yes Votes: 1,257 (71.29%)Total No Votes: 506 (28.71%)

According to the official general election report for Moniteau County:

Total Yes Votes: 175 (69.44%)Total No Votes: 77 (30.56%)

Thanks to you, we have accomplished one of our three CSIP goals! It is a privilege to be a small part of a community that provides such overwhelming support for our kids, and makes decisions to give our children what is necessary to have the very best educational experience possible!

I would like to thank Perry Gorrell for starting this process, and laying the foundation for a successful outcome. I would also like to thank the Board of Education, Cole County R-1 Staff, CTA Organization, LJ Hart, PWArchitects, and Elizabeth Wyss for their hard work and continued support to ensure our district can be the very best it can be.

We will take a little time to celebrate and give thanks for the wonderful opportunities you have helped provide. However, we still have two more CSIP goals to accomplish, and much work to ensure we deliver with fidelity what we promised regarding Proposition K.I.D.S. 
October School Board Meeting Minutes
