We have now achieved all three of our Comprehensive School Improvement Plan SMART goals for the 2022-2023 school year!

Priority Area #1 (Teaching and Learning): On January 23rd, we rolled out the power standards to the community and posted our standards on our school website. Upon the completion of our power standards, our staff has begun to unwrap them. "Unwrapping standards" includes, but is not limited to, identifying and explaining what is to be learned, describing or showing examples of proficient work, and detailing what prior knowledge, skills, and/or vocabulary is needed to master a given standard.

Priority Area #2 (Collaborative Culture/Staffing): As of February 1st, our District has made 463 total Facebook posts for the school year. Compared to January of 2022, our elementary building saw a 500% increase in Facebook posts. Our junior high/high school saw a 1,300% increase, and central office saw a 180% increase.

#### Priority Area #3 (Funding/Facilities):

- Specialized Mechanical Services installed our new HVAC in the elementary building on 1/27.
- A new sound system for the elementary gymnasium has been ordered and is awaiting installation.
- Beishir Lock and Security has been hired to work on 8 exterior doors at the elementary building.
- Metal stud framing for the walls and roof is complete at the new high school connector, and wall and roof sheathing has been installed. Construction of a fire barrier wall, temporary flashing/waterproofing, and construction of an ice and water shield are also in progress.
- Permanent railings were installed at the new exterior stairs at the Elementary building
- The junior high/high school connector is anticipated to be enclosed soon, as well as completion of electrical and above-ceiling work, and a safety inspection conducted by code officials.

#### **Board Minutes**

The Cole R1 School Board met on January 19th, 2023. Under unfinished business, a motion was made and seconded to add updated security locks to the elementary exterior doors. Under new business, a motion was made and seconded to authorize the issuance and sale of a five million dollar obligation bond. The Board also approved the 2021-2022 audit, voted to install a new sound system in the elementary gym, and to increase out-of-district tuition to \$8,500.


#### **Junior High Scholar Bowl**

### Attention parents of current 7<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> graders!!

In-School vaccination opportunity: NEW for this Spring!

On April 4, 2023, (after Nichols students return) the Cole County Health Dept. will be coming to the Jr./Sr. High School building to administer the required Tdap and MCV vaccines to 7<sup>th</sup> graders who still need them AND the second dose of MCV vaccine to 11<sup>th</sup> graders who still need it. There will not be a charge. We encourage you to take advantage of this service so your child can be up-to-date on the requirements to start 8<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grades.

Consent forms to sign up will be mailed to 7<sup>th</sup>/11<sup>th</sup> grade households whose current immunization record at school indicates needing the shots.

#### For our families who utilize Missouri Medicaid, please read:

Medicaid Annual Renewals to start April 1, 2023 — https://mydss.mo.gov/renew

The Family Support Division will be required to check the eligibility of **all MO HealthNet (Missouri Medicaid)** participants, which includes Managed Care health plan members of Healthy Blue, Home State Health, and United Healthcare. This is called a Medicaid eligibility renewal (or annual renewal). There are two steps you need to take to make sure you complete your renewal by the deadline:

**STEP 1:** Get ready for renewals by keeping your contact information up to date so you can get important updates in the mail. **If your address has changed in the last 3 years, you will need to notify the Family Support Division by:** 

- —Reporting a change online
- —Visiting your **local resource center**
- —Calling **855-353-4636**

**STEP 2:** You will receive a letter in the mail sometime between April 2023 and April 2024. You can check the **annual renewal timeline** to find out when you should expect to get your letter. This letter will tell you what, if anything, you need to do next. If a response is required, make sure to submit it by the deadline so you do not risk losing your healthcare coverage.
