As the fall season settles in and our classrooms are filled with learning and activity, I want to take a moment to celebrate recent accomplishments, share important updates, and highlight the many ways our district continues to grow and thrive. The dedication of our staff, students, and community is what makes Cole County R-1 such a special place to learn and lead.

Board of Education Updates

2025-2026 Bus Routes Approved

At the October Board of Education meeting, the Board approved our transportation routes for the 2025–2026 school year. Each year, routes are reviewed to ensure safety, efficiency, and compliance with DESE and audit standards.

This year's updates include:

- •6 Durham routes serving grades K-12
- •1 career education route to Nichols Career Center (added to meet growing demand)
- •1 district-operated Special Education route to KVC in Columbia
- •1 district-operated route to the Early Childhood Center in Jefferson City

We're proud to maintain high standards of safety and accessibility for all students while remaining cost-effective.

District-Wide Security Camera Upgrade

The Board also approved a **new district-wide security camera system** by Sound Solutions. This \$108,070 project—funded within our 2022 bond—will replace all cameras and wiring across the district, improving both coverage and reliability. The system will be installed by January 2026 and include remote monitoring and cybersecurity enhancements.
